

**Requirements for qualifying for graduation course
"MEDICAL CHEMISTRY"
(1st DM)
year 2012/2013**

I. For successful completion credit of practical exercises is required:

- Compulsory attendance on at least 75% of all of lectures held during semester.
- Participation in all (100%) practical exercises, theoretical and methodological manage practical tasks.
- Get at least 65% of the total score for ongoing review of the Theoretical training to practical exercises. Monitoring is done at every practice (except in the following paragraph), lecturing on topics from the previous week and substance-related exercise for the week writing (small test). The evaluation is assessing the results of practical tasks and protocols.
- Get at least 65% on average from 3 tests per semester refresher (Repeating test from Inorganic, Repeating test from Organic Chemistry and Repeating test from Bioorganic Chemistry - big tests).
- In the case where a student does not write repeating test due date or without sufficient evaluation, the test may be repeated only once in the last week of the semester.
- In the case where a student obtains 65% (average of three repeating tests) nor in the last week of the semester, the only exception to repeat the test once within the deadline set with agreement of own teacher.

II. On successful completion of testing is necessary:

- Granting credit for practical exercises.
- Successfully managing a written examination.
- The written test consists of a test consisting of 30 questions within the substance of the curriculum.
 - The tests are written in the assembly hall of 60 min.
 - After – the tests are evaluated by teachers, department.
 - The quality of answers – for each student receives a question from 4 to 0 points. Maximum number of points for the whole test is 120.
 - Examiners teachers make a – final evaluation by the test with the number obtained 72 points or more, added bonus for their work on practical exercises as follows:
 - a) the percentage reached from Refresher tests (90 -100%) 5 points
 - b) the percentage reached from Refresher tests (80 to 89%) 3 points
 - Examiners teachers – determine the test result by point scale as follows:

120 – 108 points	1	excellent	A
107 – 100 points	1–	very good	B
99 – 90 points	2	good	C
89 – 80 points	2–	satisfactory	D
79 – 72 points	3	suffiecient	E
< 72 points	4	fail	FX

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
