

Requirements for completion of „**BIOCHEMISTRY 2**“  
2nd year, GM  
*Acad. year 2012/2013*

**1. For successful acquisition of the credit for course of Biochemistry 2 is required:**

- a) Compulsory attendance on at least 75 % of all of lectures held during semester.
- b) To participate on all of practical exercises, theoretical and practical performance of all exercises.
- c) To get at least **60 %** of total score for on-going review of the theoretical training to practical exercises.
- d) Monitoring is done at every practice from topics related to the exercise of the week – small tests or oral examination.
- e) In the case of excused absence, the preparation of seminar work and its presentation in writings form (PowerPoint or poster, 10 - 15 min.) for a topic given by supervisor, submit a written form (6 - 10 pages, used literature, Times New Roman 12, 1,5 line spacing).
- f) To get at least **60 %** (average) from **3 revision tests** (big tests, **15 questions**).
- g) The result **over 90%** on average from all of big tests written in winter (WS) and summer (SS) semesters substitute a written part of the exam (student need not to write a test on exam).
- a) In the case, than student obtained less than 60 % (in average) from the 3 “big” tests, can write the credit test in the last week of the semester. Credit test will contain 15 questions from full curriculum prescribed for Biochemistry 2 in the SS.
- h) Credit test can be repeated **only once** in the term for writing examination set for students from Biochemistry 2.

**2. For successful completion of the exam from Biochemistry 2 is necessary:**

- a) To gain the credit from practical exercises (paragraph 1 above).
- b) The final exam consists of written part - test (the result over 90 % on average from all of big tests written during WS and SS may substitute a written part of the exam) and oral part. - c) The written tests:
  - are composed of 25 questions from the curriculum of Biochemistry;
  - are written in the assembly hall for 45 min;
  - are evaluated by teachers of the department;
  - every student receives for his/her answer from 0 (incorrect or no answer) to 4 points (fully correct answer) per question;
  - maximum number of points means 100 (100 %) for whole test;
  - the final mark of the written test is determined by the scale as follows:

100 - 92 % correct answers	1	excellent	A
91 - 85 % correct answers	1-	very good	B
84 - 75 % correct answers	2	good	C
74 - 68 % correct answers	2-	satisfactory	D
67 - 60 % correct answers	3	sufficient	E
< 60 % correct answers	4	fail	FX
- d) The final classification is the result of the evaluation of practical exercises, written tests and oral responses.

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
