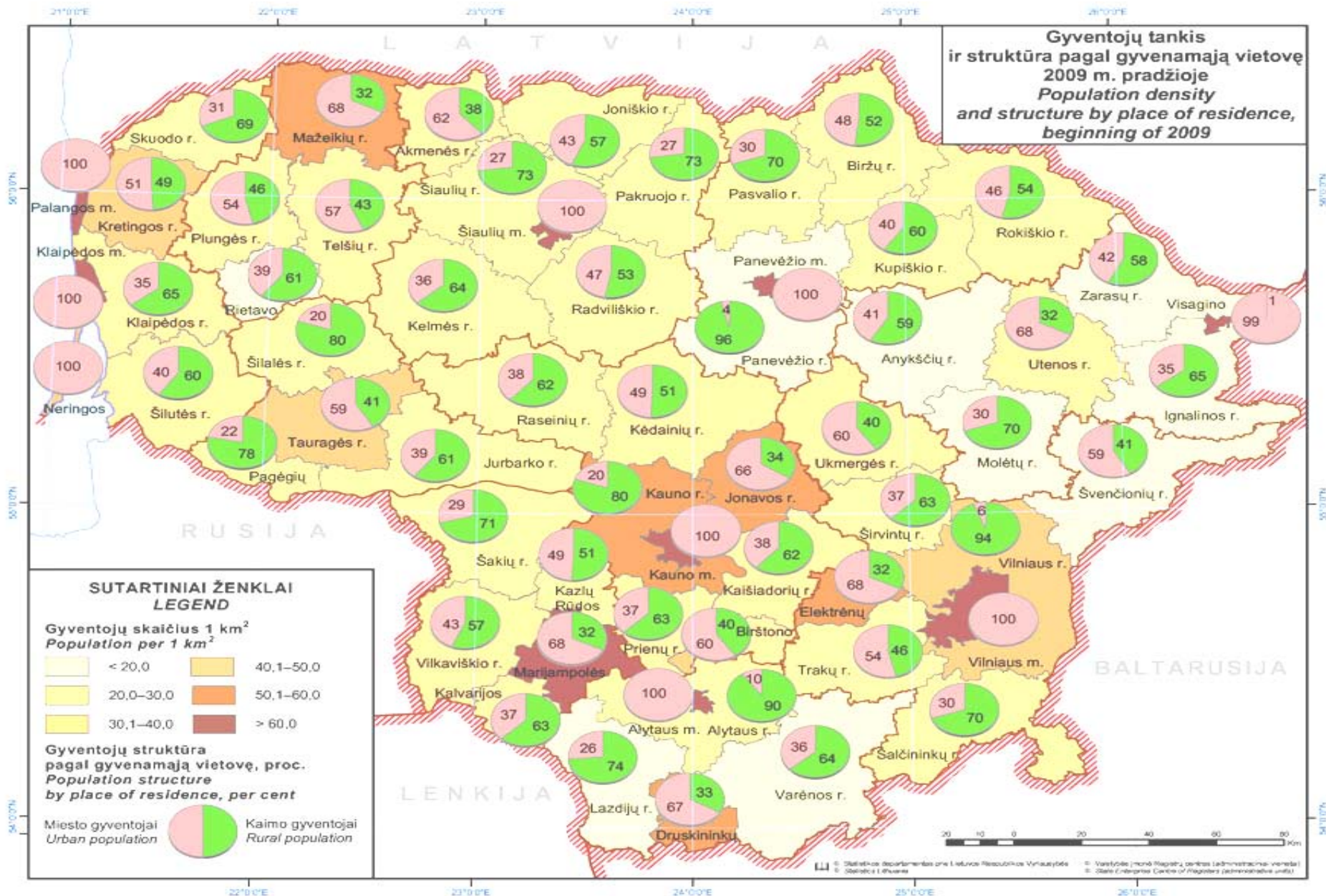

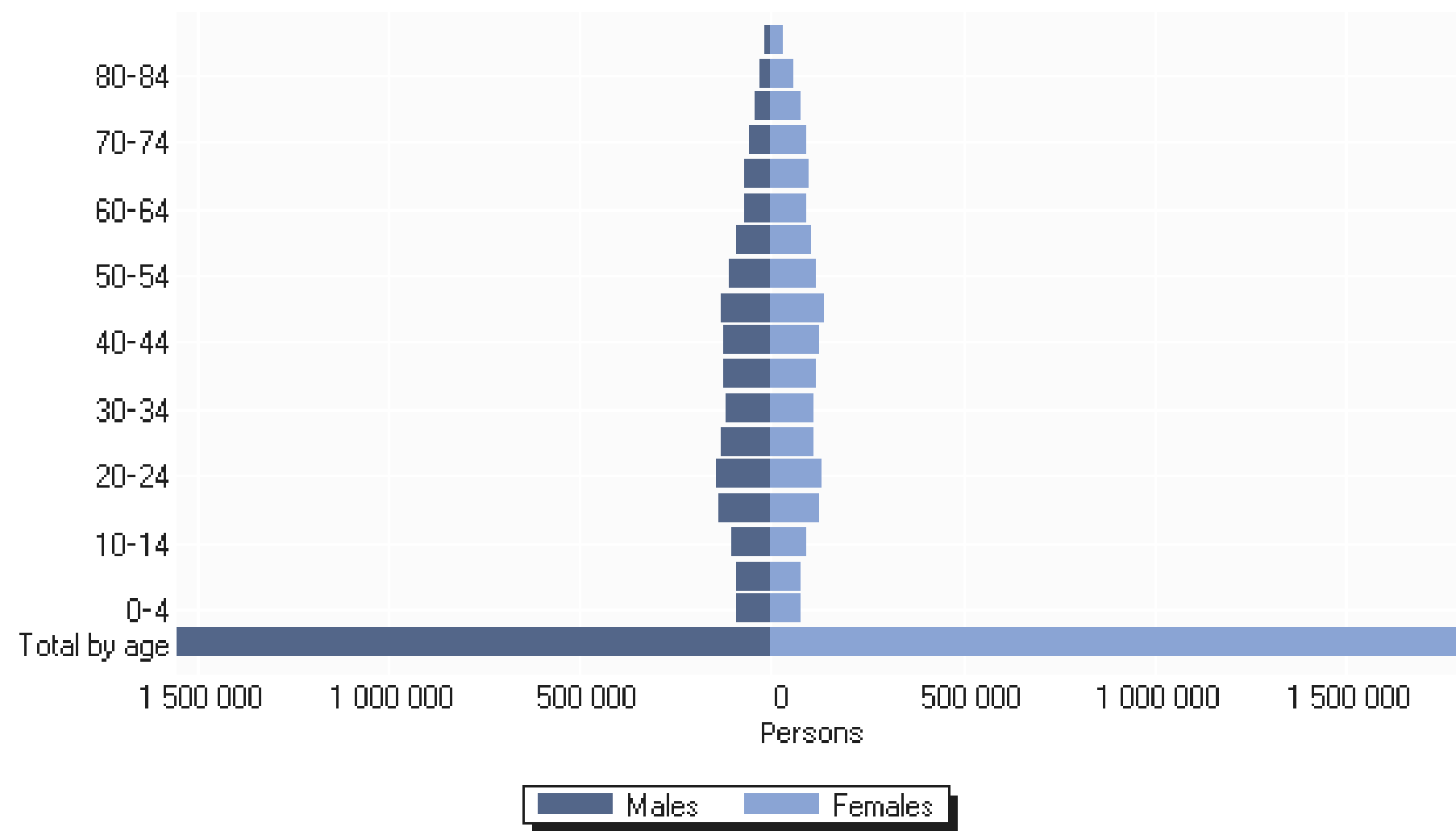
- **Territory: 65 303 km²**

Population density and structure by place of residence, beginning of 2009

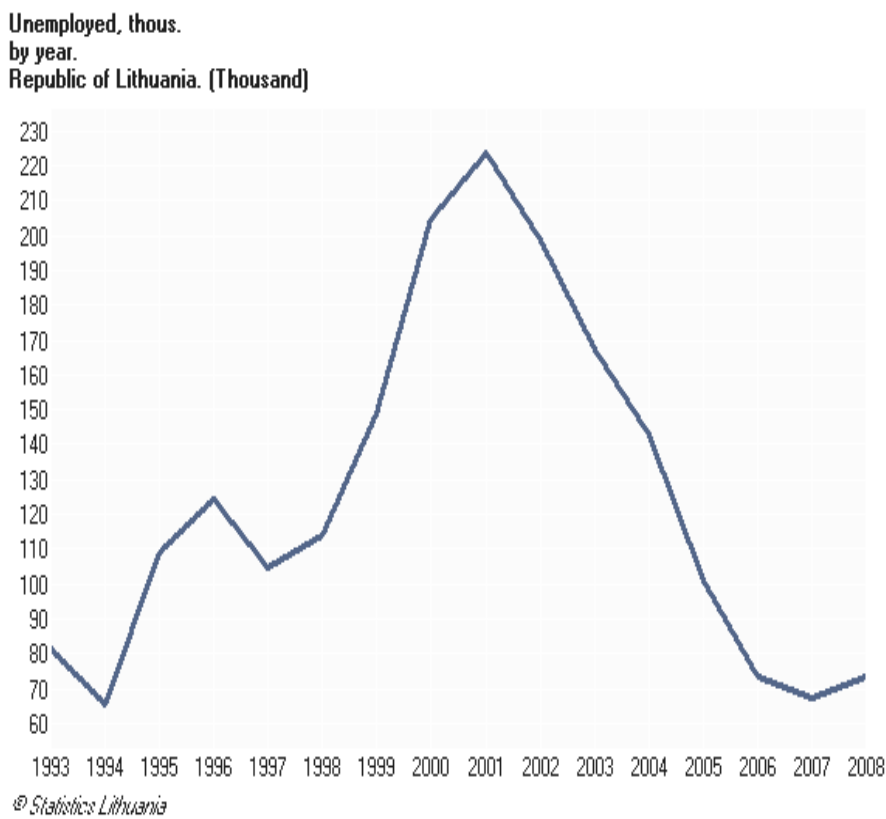


Population by sex and age

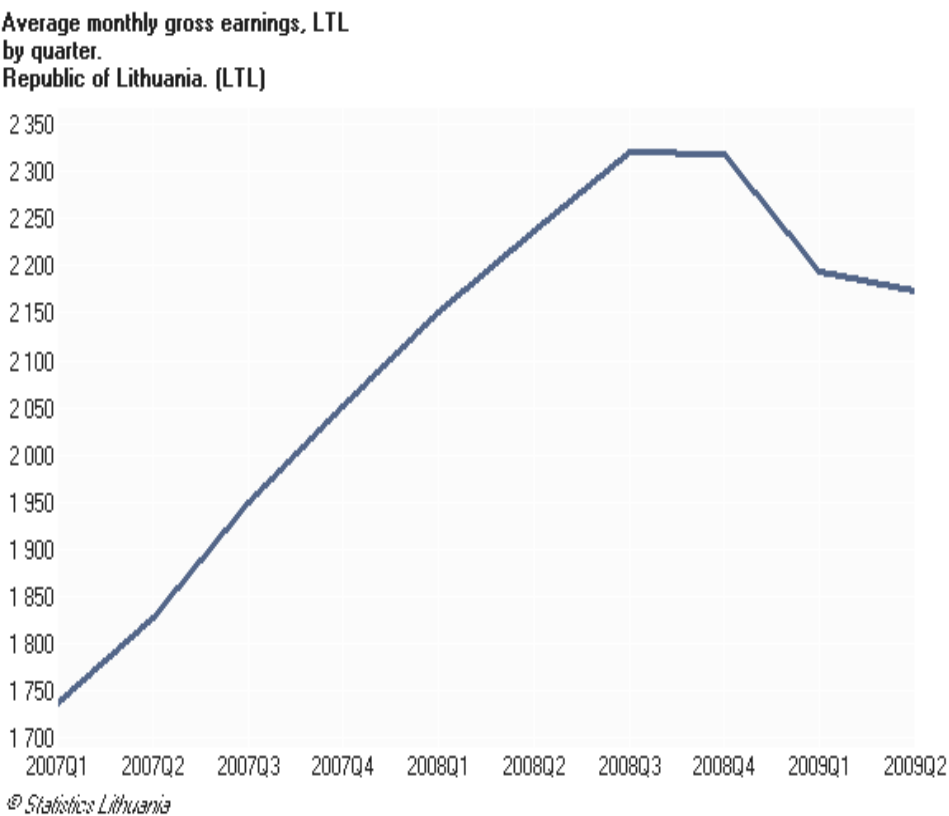
Population as of 1 January

Unemployed trend (thouthands) (1994-2008)

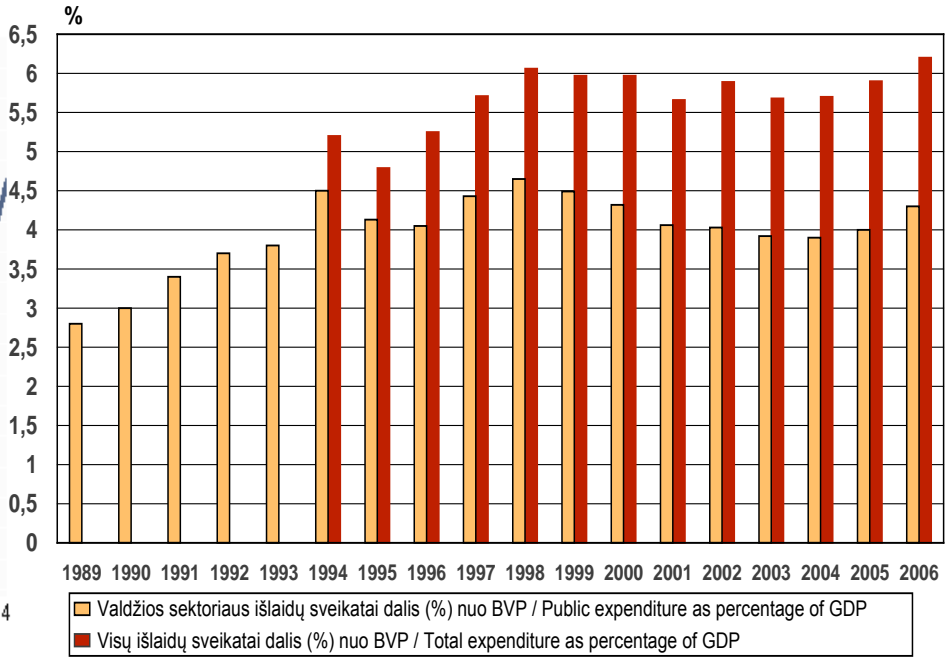
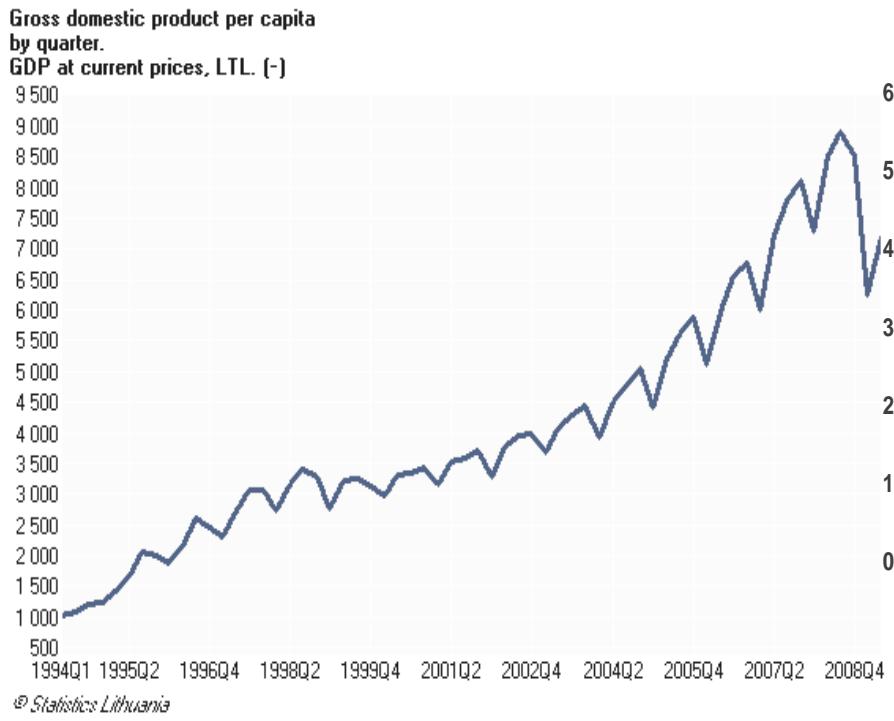


Average monthly gross earnings by quarter (2007-2009)

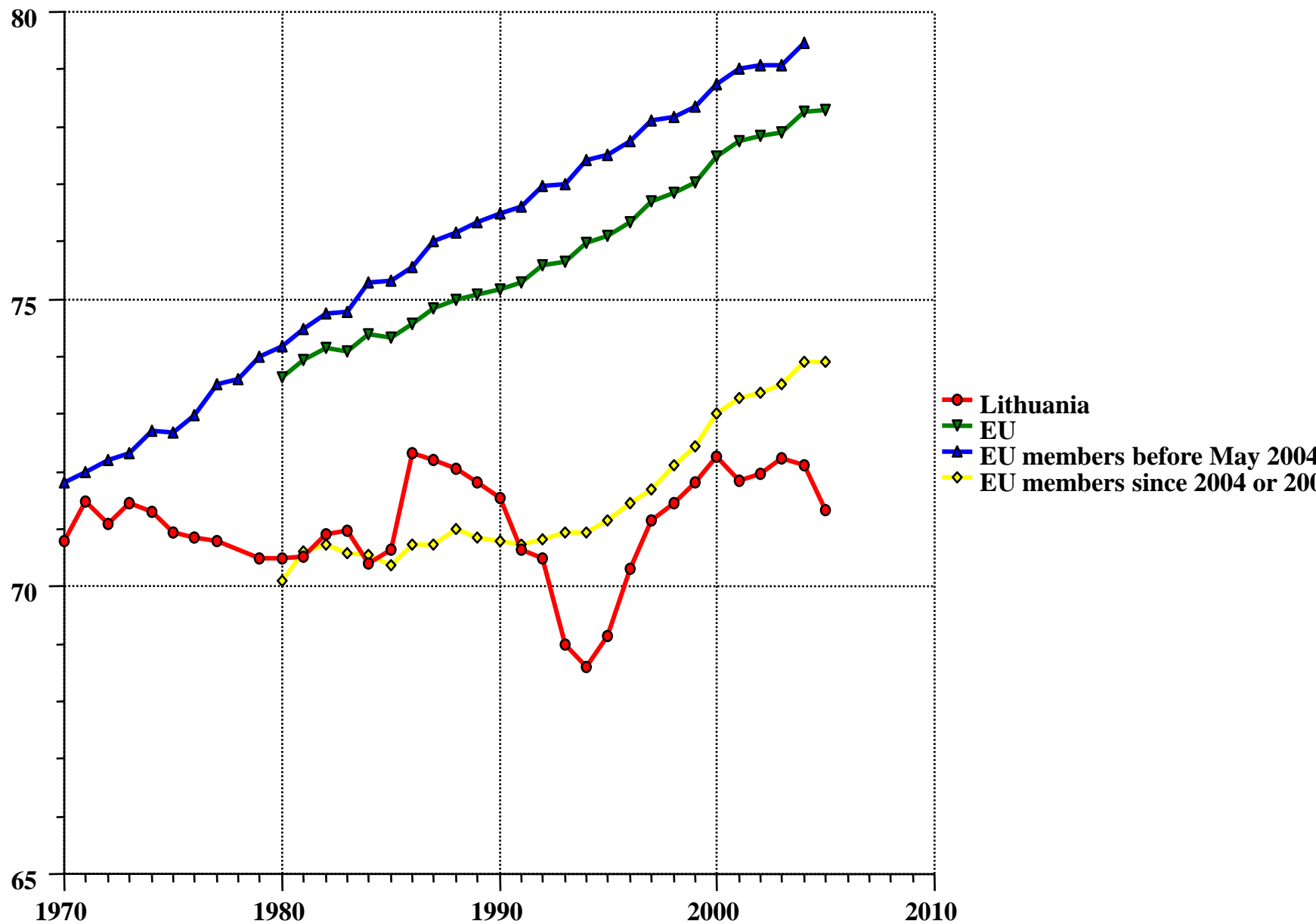


GPD per capita

Expenditure on Health as Percentage of GDP (1989-2006)

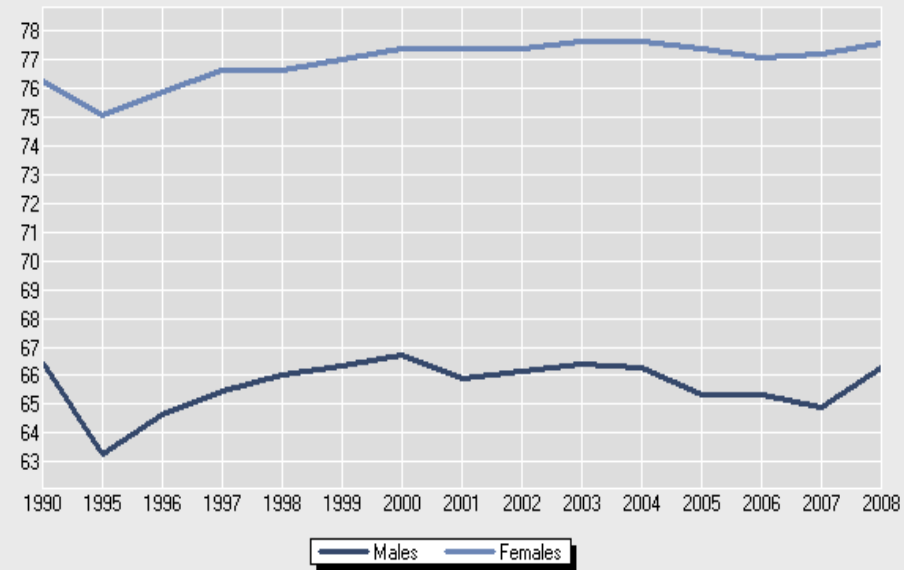


Life expectancy at birth, years



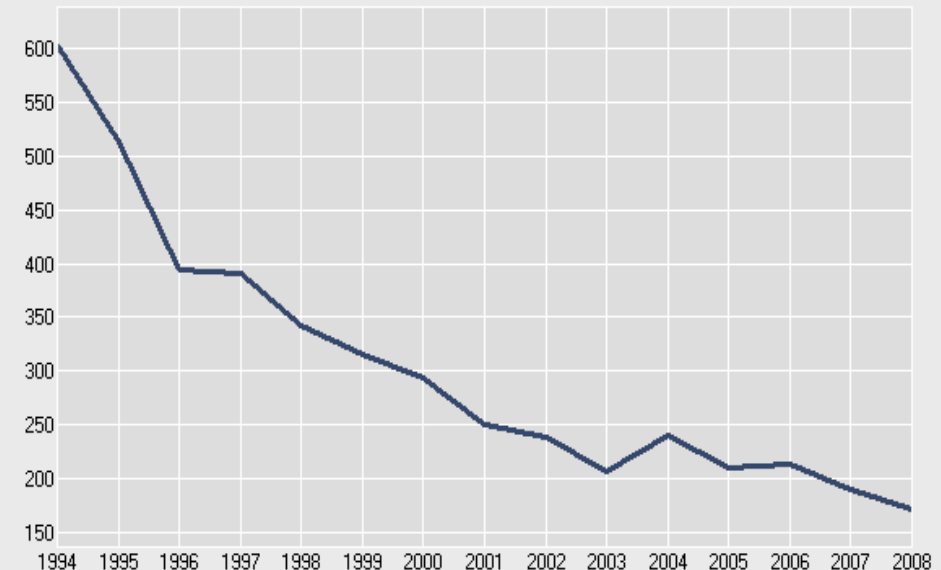
Life expectancy at birth by sex and year (1990-2008)

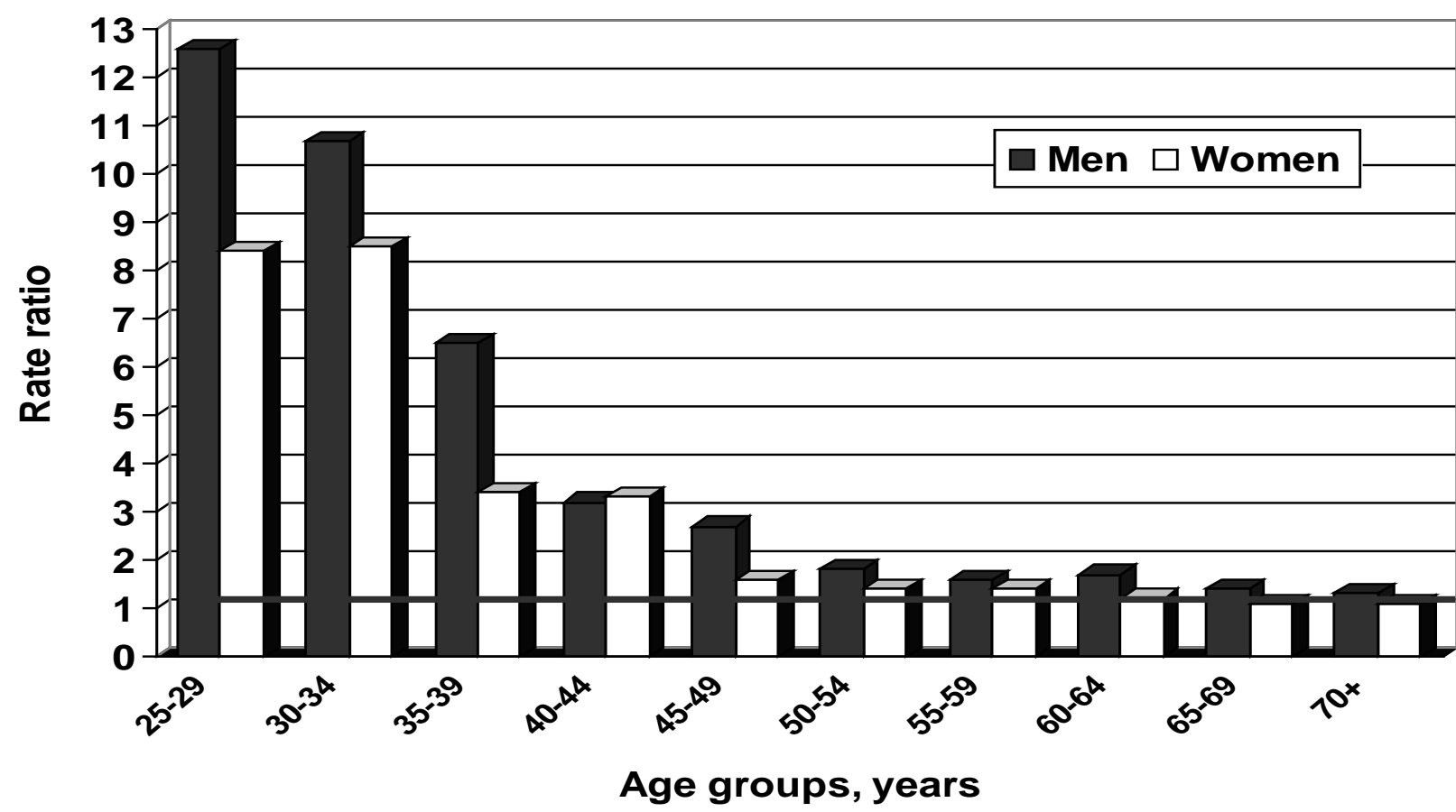


Infants mortality trend (1994-2008)

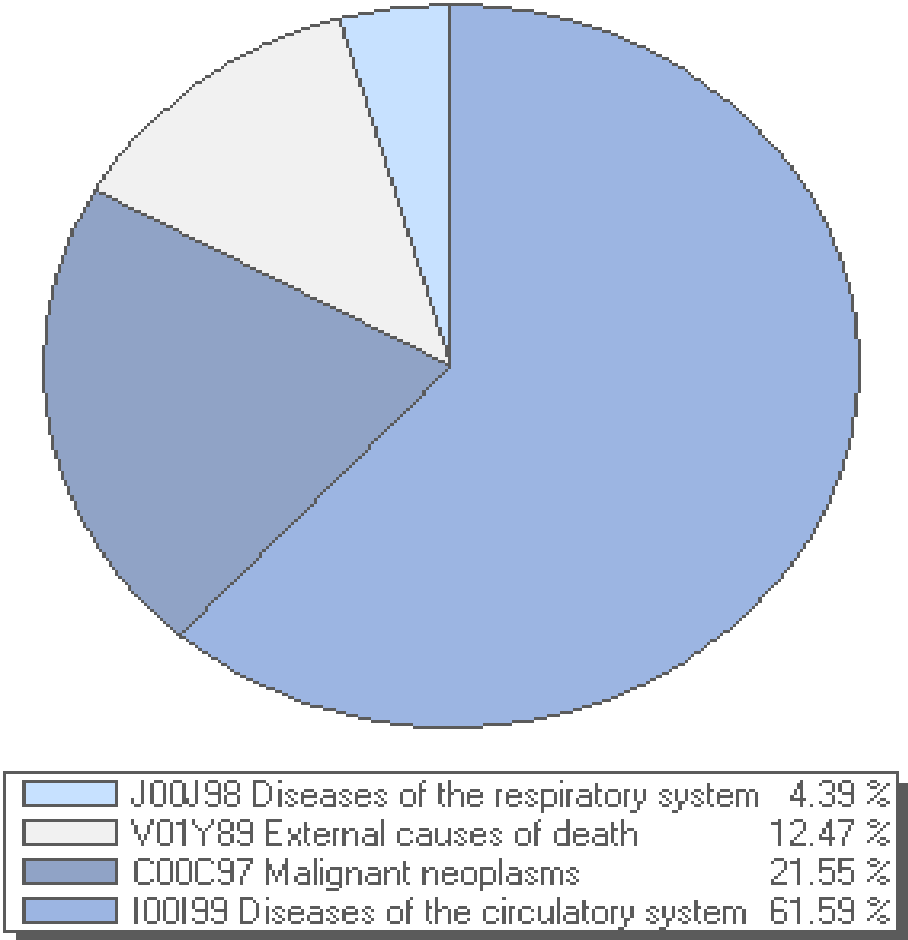
***Comparison of age-specific mortality between population groups with university and primary education

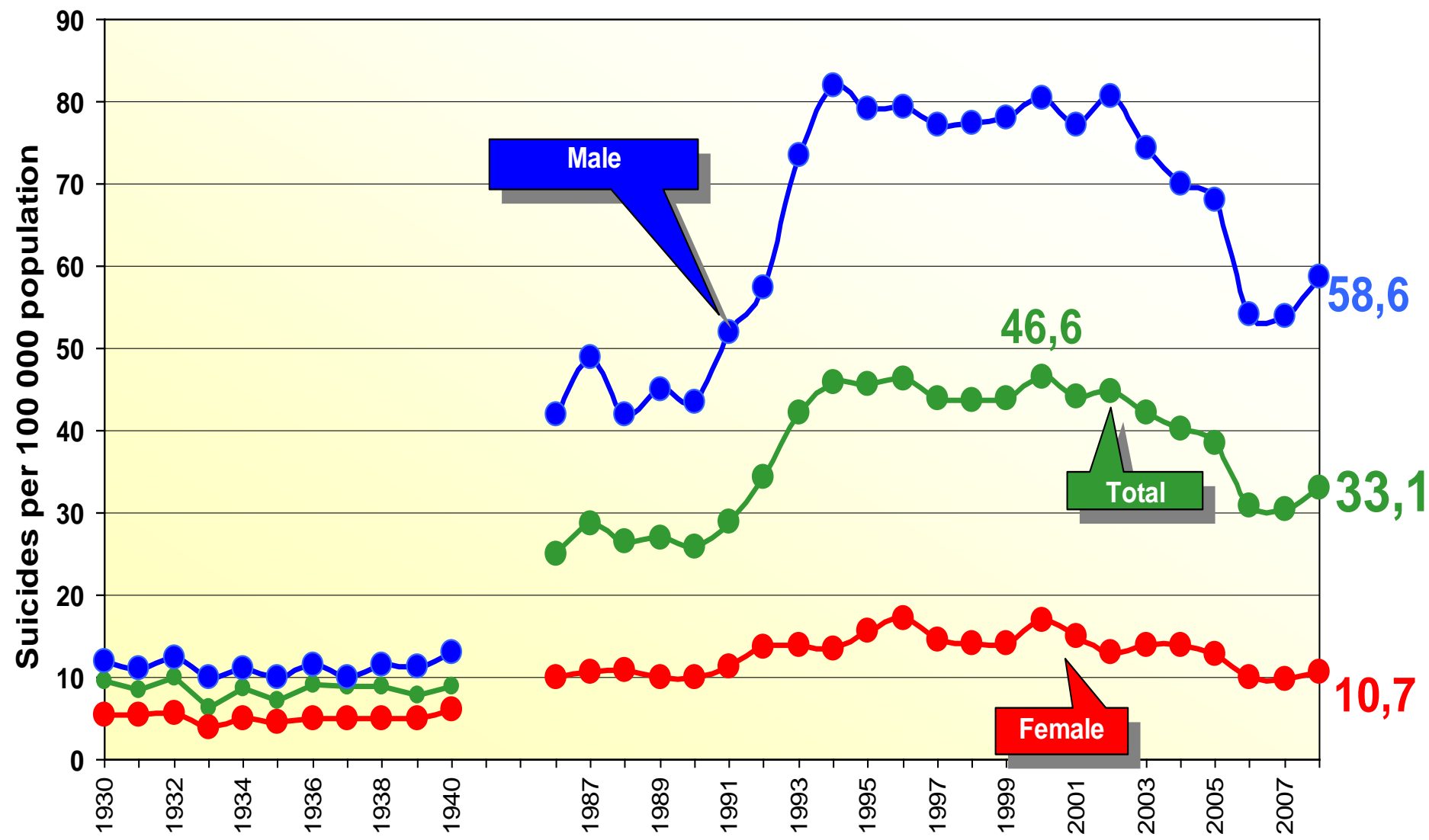
Main causes of death in Lithuania, 2008

Republic of Lithuania, 2008. (Per 100 000 population)



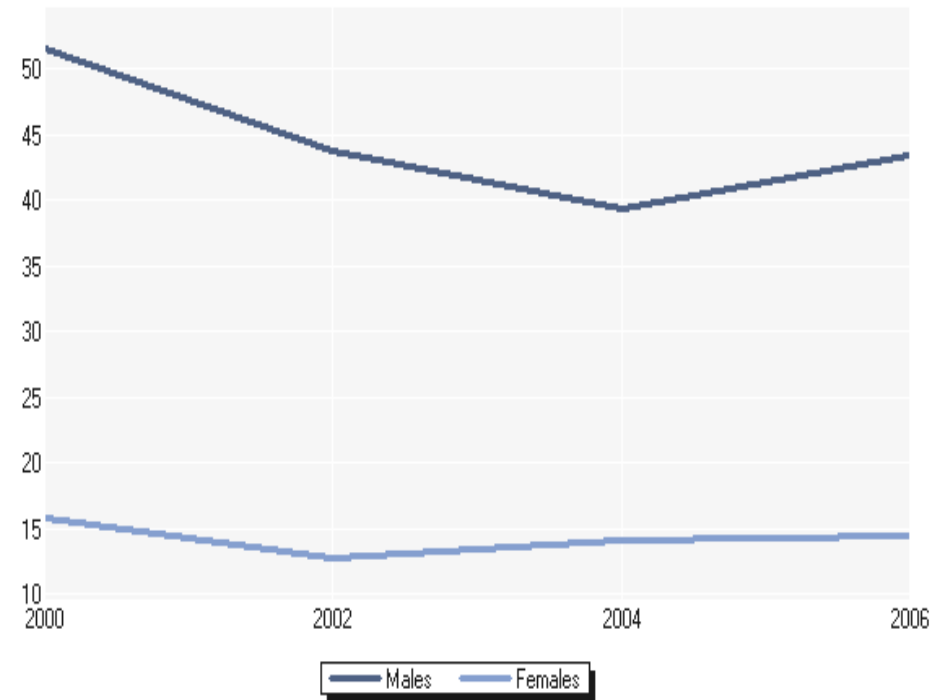
SUICIDES IN LITHUANIA 1930-1940 AND 1987-2008

(per 100 000)



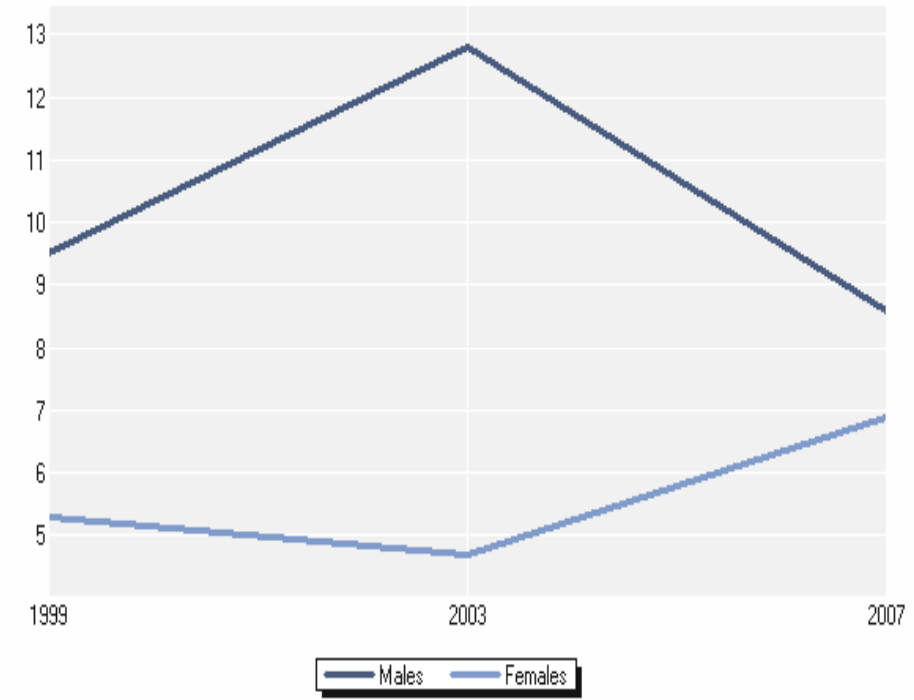
Daily smoking population by gender (2000-2006)

Alcohol consumption among 15-16 years age of pupils

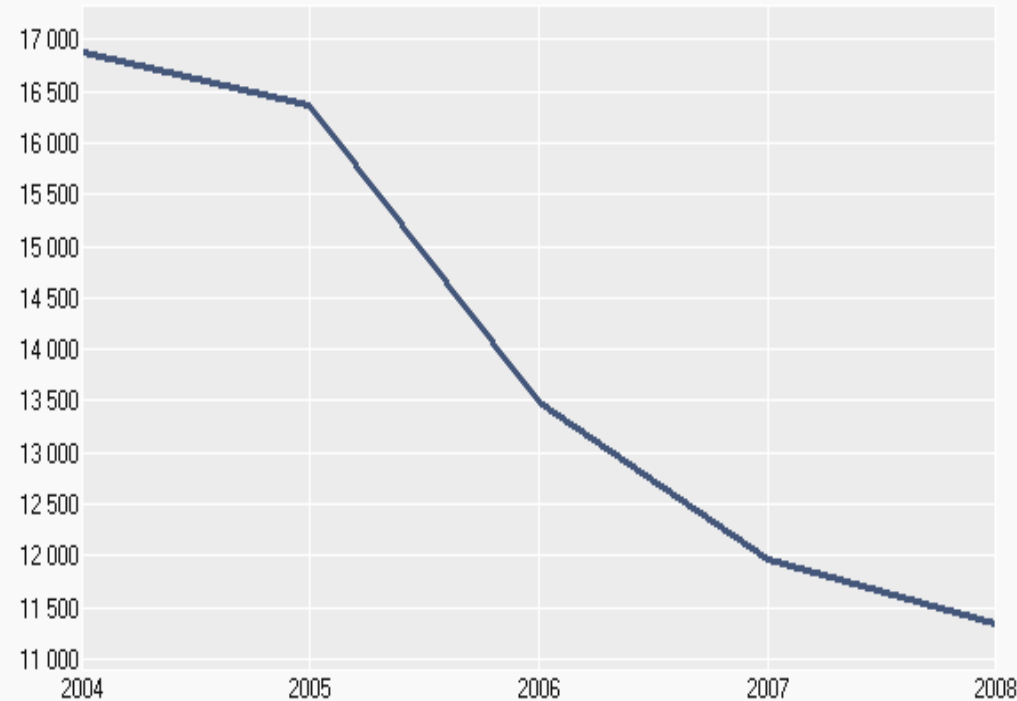
Alcohol consumption among 15-16 years age of pupils by sex and year.
